• Gambling Disorder is an Addiction Just Like Heroin, Opioids, Tobacco, Alcohol and Cocaine



1. Needs to gamble with increasing amounts of money in order to achieve the desired excitement.

2. Is restless or irritable when attempting to cut down or stop gambling.

3. Has made repeated ursuccessful efforts to control, cut back, or stop gambling.

It is often preoccupied with gambling (e.g., having persistent thoughts of reliving past gambling experiences, thinking of ways to get money with which to gamble).

5. Often gambles when feeling distressed (e.g., helpless, guilty, anxious, depressed).

7. Lies to conceal the extent of involvement with gambling. 8. Has jeopardized or lost a significant relationship, job, or educational or career opportunity because of gambling.

9. Relies on others to provide money to relieve desperate financial situations caused by gambling.




## **Expansion of Online Gambling**

- 39 States and the District of Columbia have Legalized Sports Gambling.
- 30 of 39 have Legalized Online Sports Gambling.
- 7 States have Legalized Online Casino Gambling.
- As States Legalize Online Gambling , Calls to Problem Gambling Hotlines Increa se.













## May 2023 NCAA SPORTS GAMBLING SURVEY

- Sports wagering is pervasive among college students with 58% of 18 – 22year-olds engaging in sports gambling.
- Sports Gambling is widespread on college campuses with 67% of students betting on sports. Students living on or near campus gamble at higher frequencies.
- Nearly 60% of students are likely to bet on sports after seeing a gambling advertisement.




### May 2023 NCAA SPORTS GAMBLING SURVEY

- More than 60% of students engaged in gambling are betting on sports using the highly addictive "in game/micro bets".
- Nearly 80% indicate that betting on sports makes it more likely they will watch the event on television or streaming.
- 60% of student gamblers believe they can and will make money betting on sports.

## NFL COMMISSIONER ROGER GOODELL (2012)

"The NFL cannot be compensated in damages for the harm that sports gambling poses to the goodwil, character, and integrity of NFL Football, and to the fundamental bonds of loyalty, and devotion between fans and teams that the league seeks to maintain. Once the character and integrity of NFL Football have been compromised, and the bonds of loyalty and devotion between fans and teams that we been broken, NFL Football will have been irreparably injured in a manner that cannot be calculated in dollars."





## 2017: NFL Commissioner Roger Goodell

- The spread of legalized sports gambling would change forever and for the worse—what our games stand for and how they are perceived.

## 2018: Murphy v NCAA: "The legalization of sports gambling requires an important policy choice...... Congress can regulate sports gambling directly, but if a elects not to do so, each State is free to act on its own" (Murphy v NCAA, 2018).

- Congressman Paul Tonko (NY-20) and Senator Richard Blumenthal (CT).
- Federal Regulation of Online Sports Gambling. Minimum Safety Standards.
- Affordability Checks and Deposit Limits.
- Transparency with Sports' Data
- Strict Advertising and Affiliate Regulations.



## The SAFE Bet Act (2024 and 2025)

- Bans Credit Cards for Gambling.
- Restricts the Use of Artificial Intelligence.
- Bans In-game Micro-betting.
- Age Restrictions on Apps.
- Ends Player Prop Bets on College Sports.
- Collaboration to eliminate offshore sportsbooks.
- Disclosure of true odds.
